# FIRST YEAR

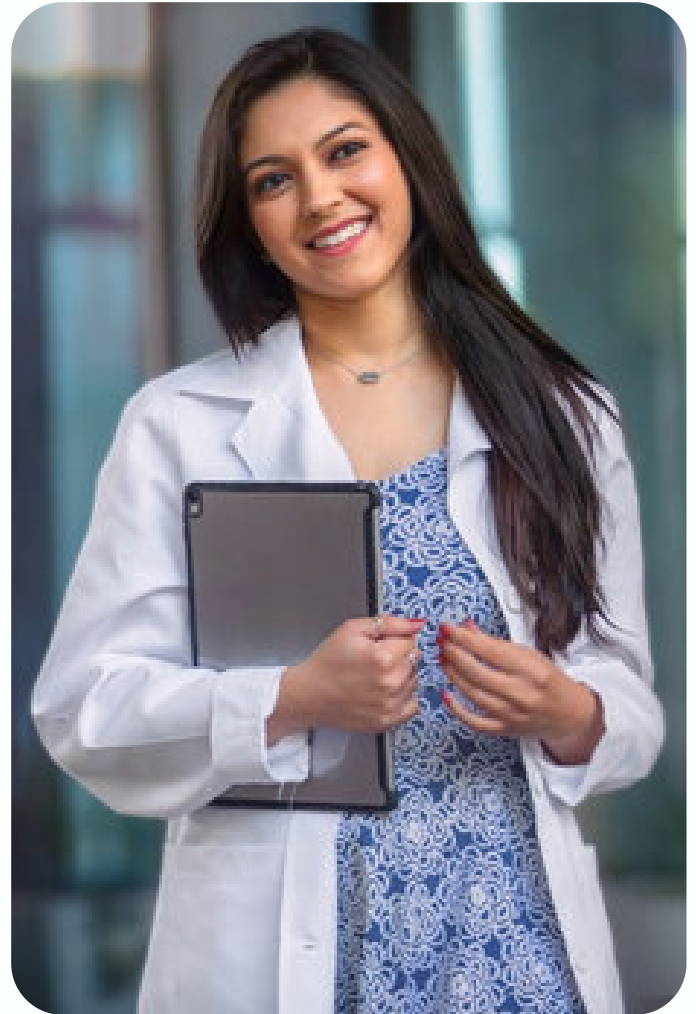

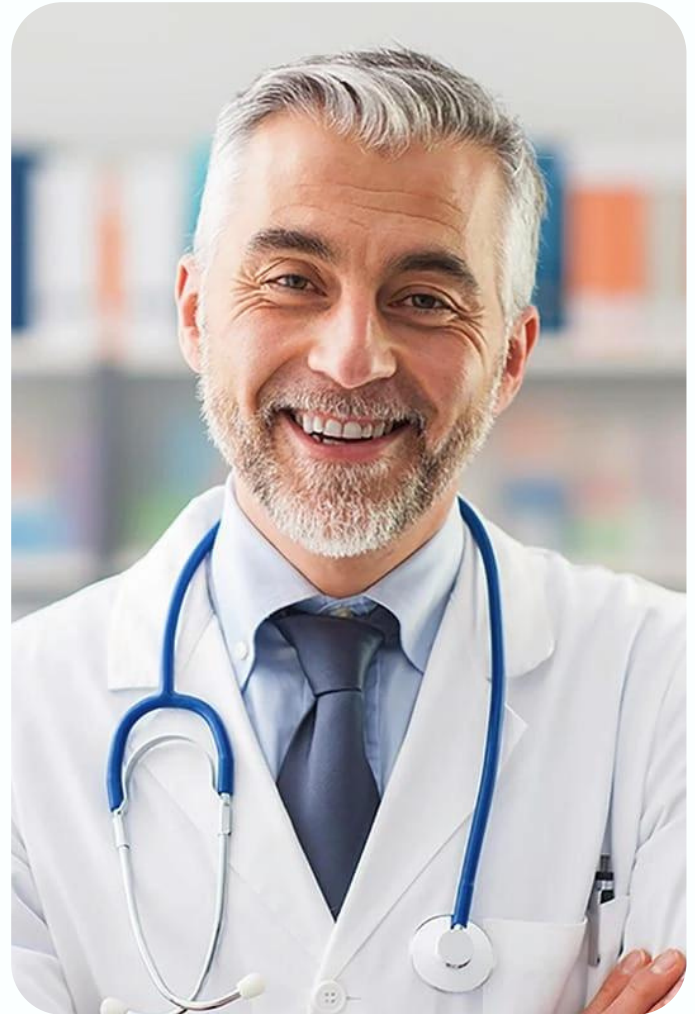

The fifth and sixth year offer the students to practice their medical profession under expert guidance and supervision beforehand of becoming a full-fledged medical practitioner.

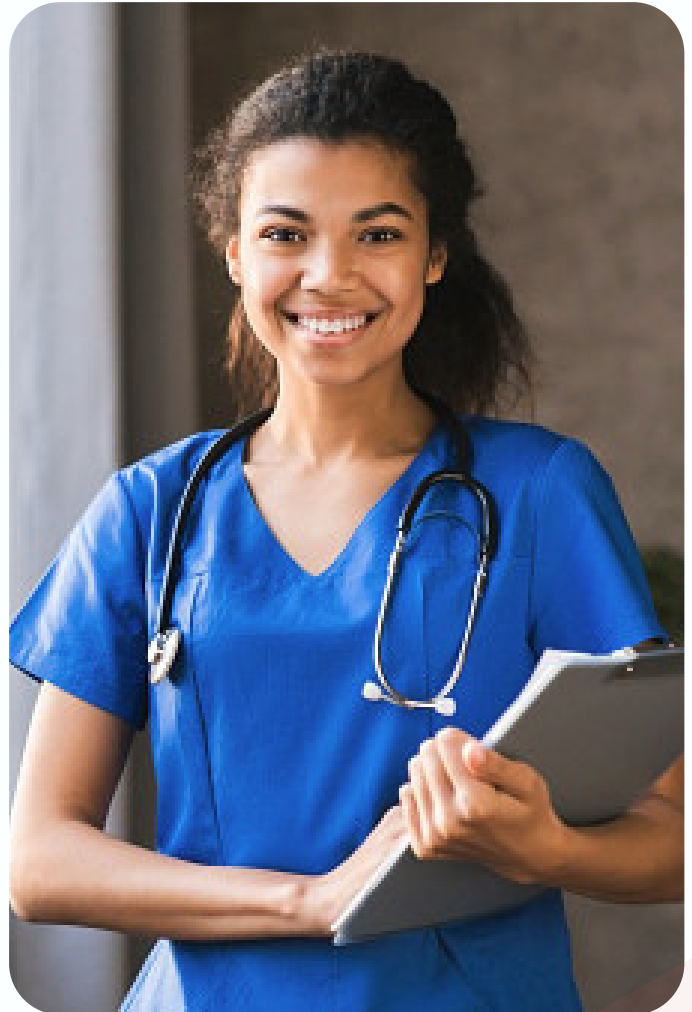

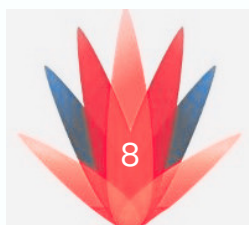
