The second year offer the students an opportunity to develop a strong background in pediatric therapy and to receive an introduction to geriatric disorders and its therapy.

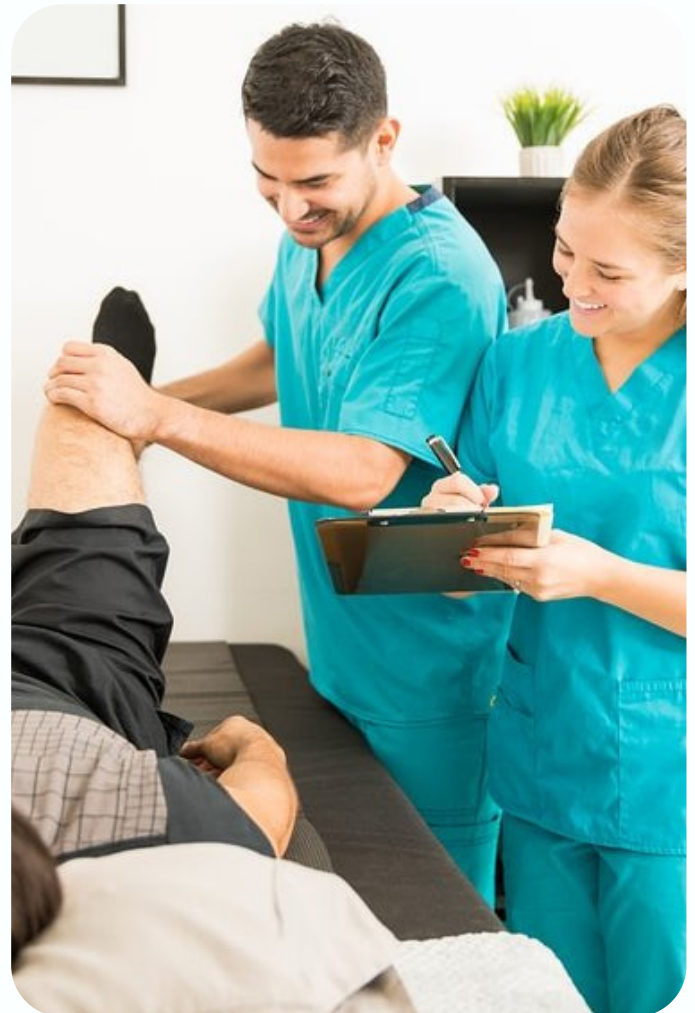

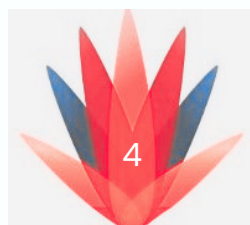

The fifth and sixth year offer the students to practice their physical therapy profession under expert guidance and supervision beforehand of becoming a full-fledged physical therapist.

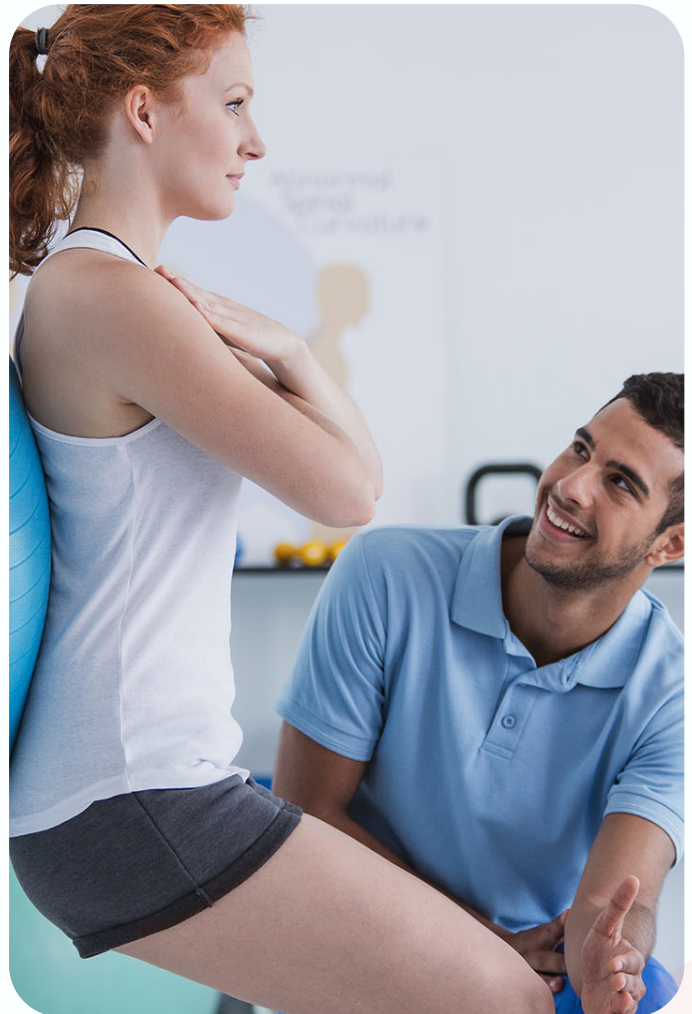
