FIRST YEAR

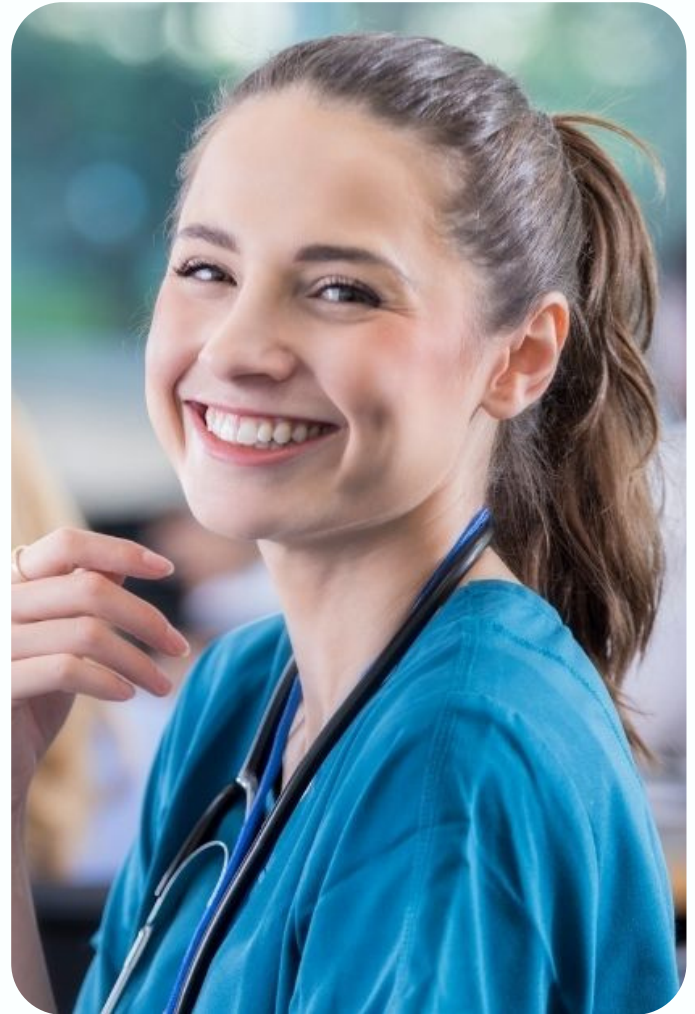

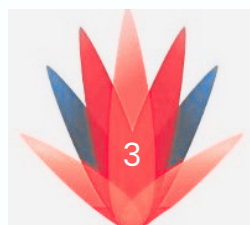

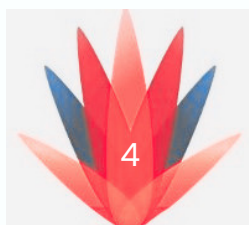
