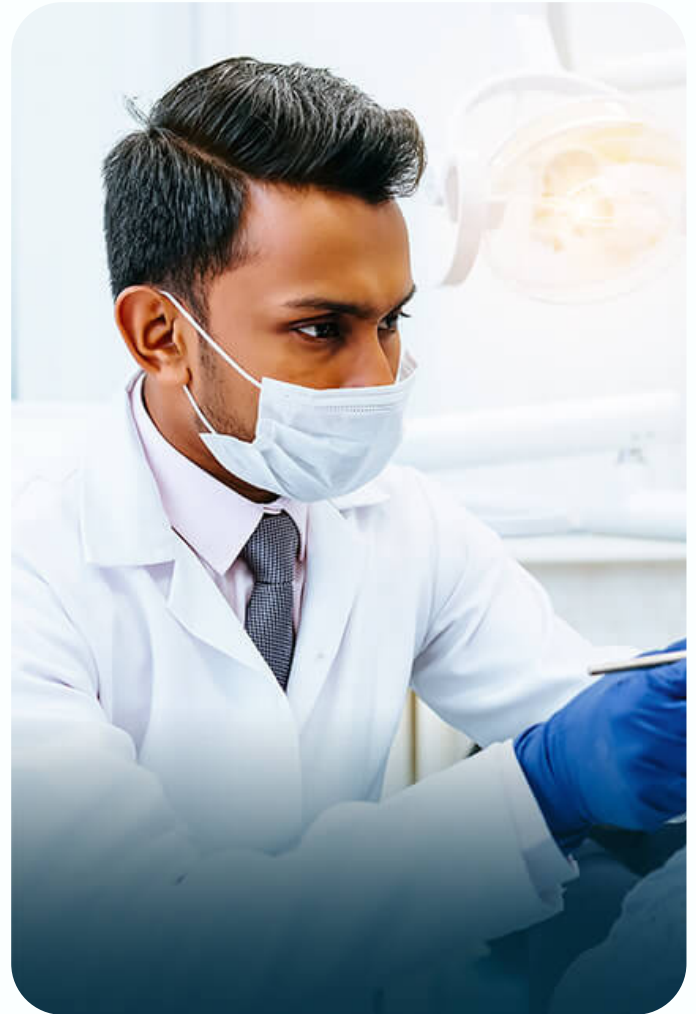
University of Dr.PSJKumar School of Science and Medicine has various programs for diplomas, degrees, masters, and doctorates.

FIRST YEAR

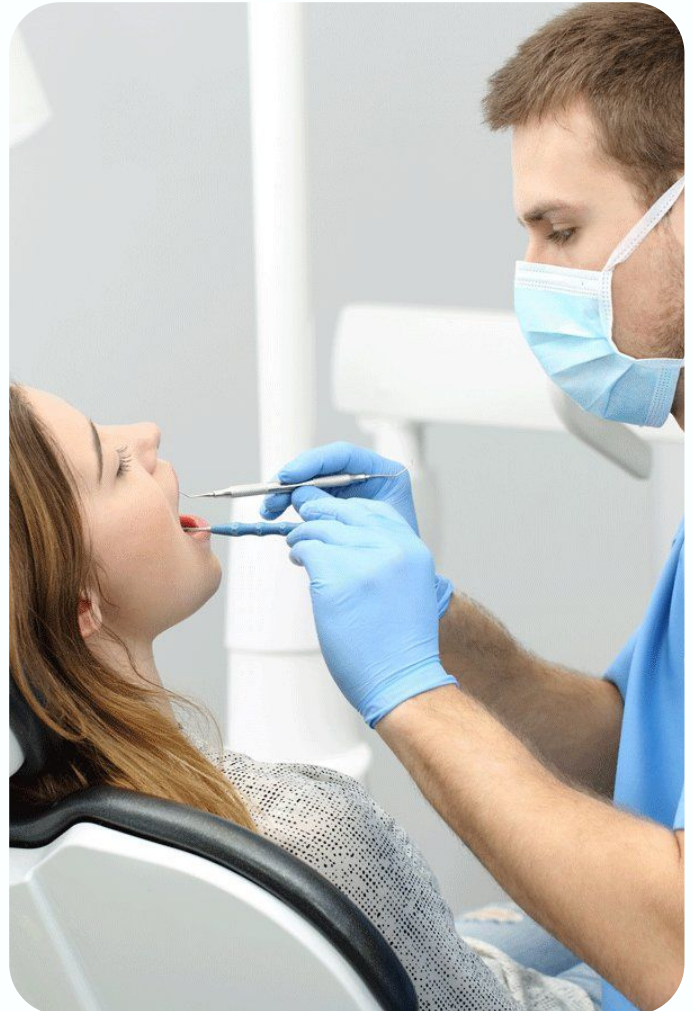

The second year offer the students an opportunity to learn the basic dental science and to receive an introduction to the pediatric and adult dentistry.

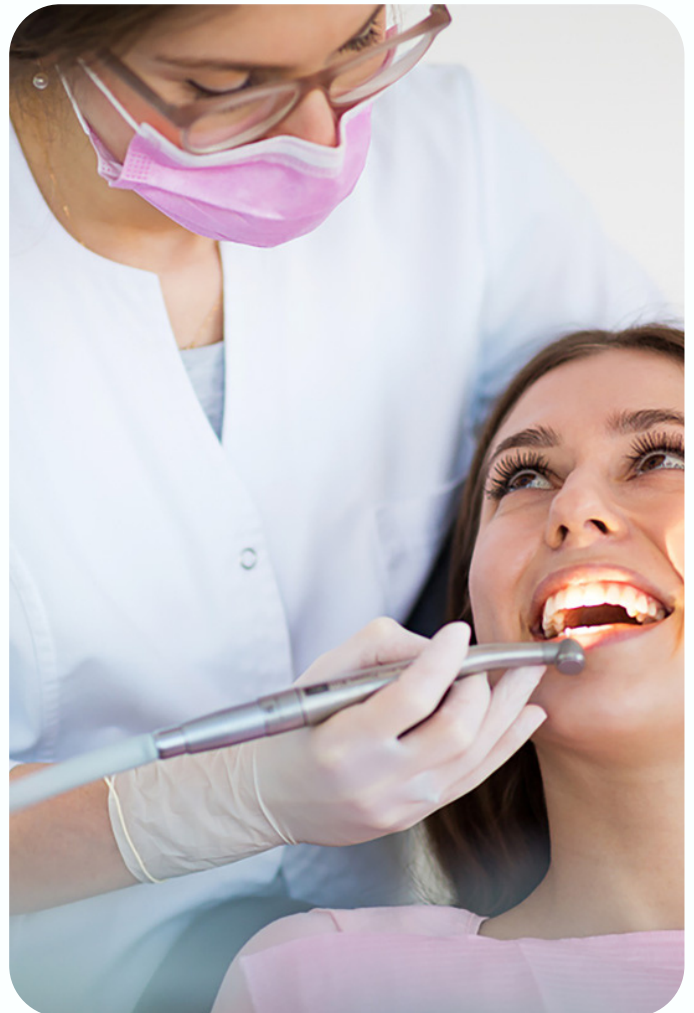

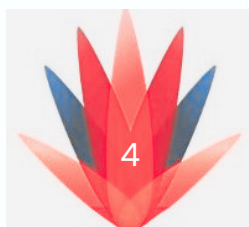

THIRD YEAR

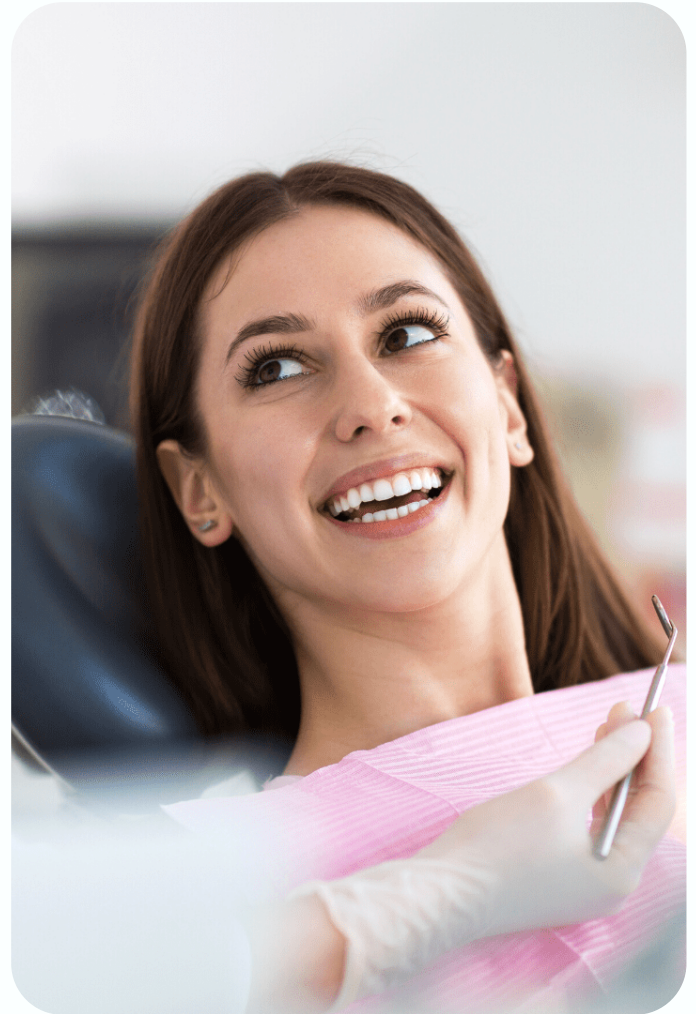
The third year offer the students an opportunity to develop a strong background in the basic dental surgery and to receive an introduction to the facial surgery.

The fourth year offer the students an opportunity to develop a strong background in community health dentistry, advanced dental care clerkship and public health dentistry.

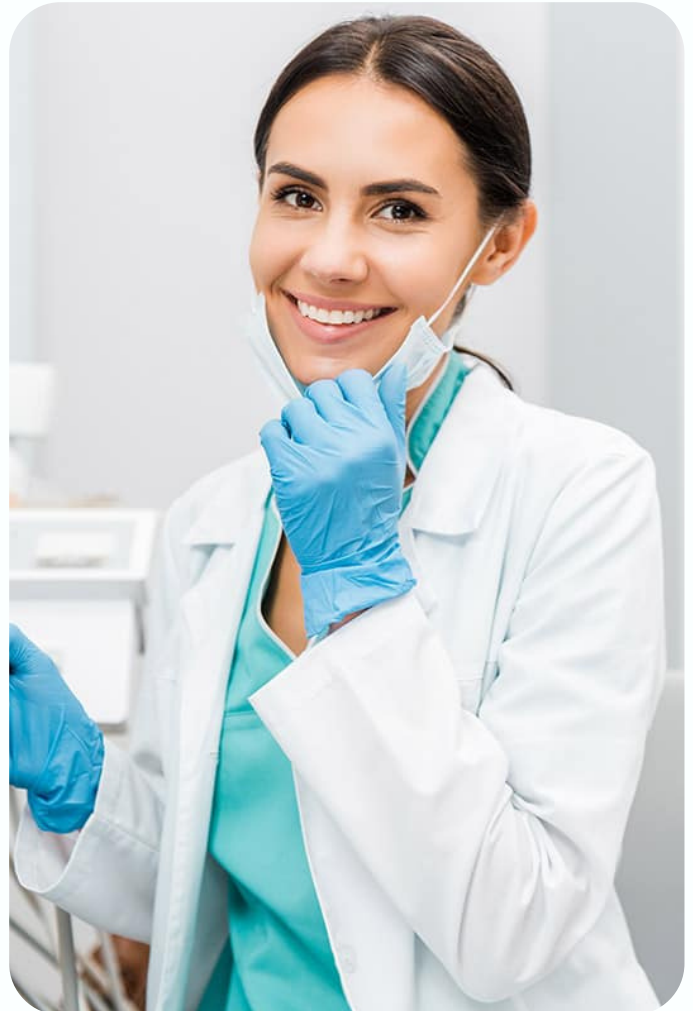

The fifth and sixth year offer the students to practice their dental profession under expert guidance and supervision beforehand of becoming a full-fledged dental practitioner and dental surgeon.

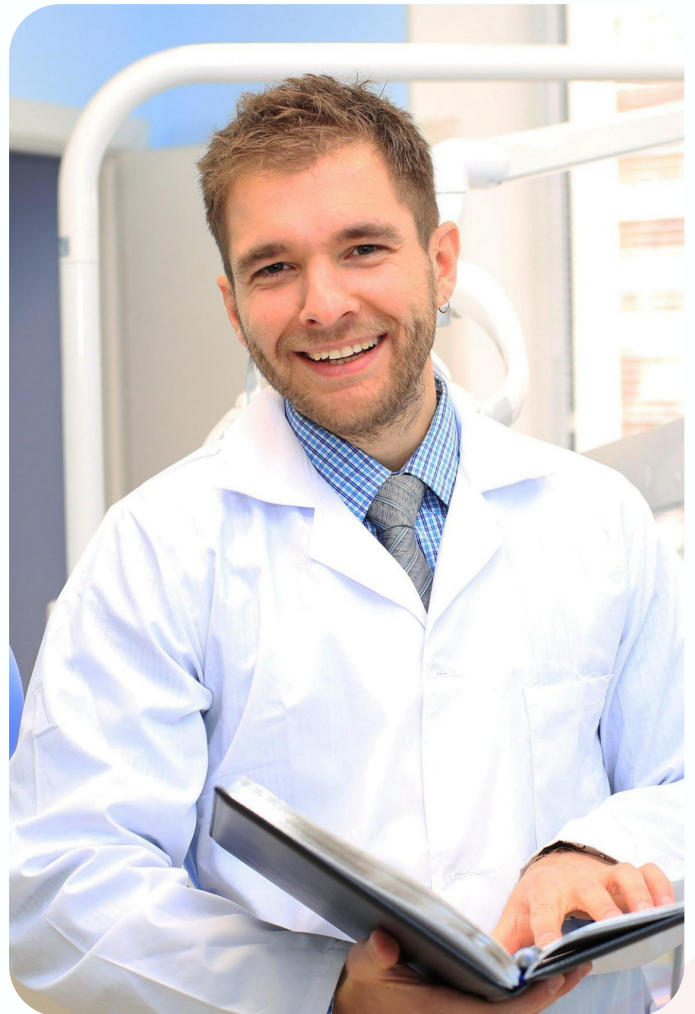
