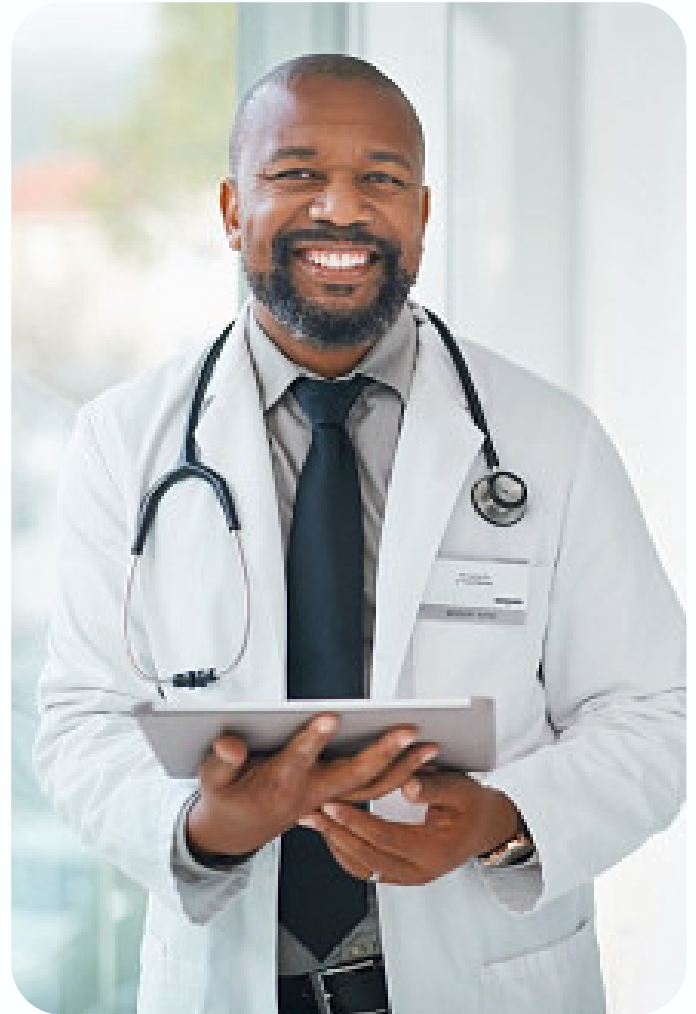

FIRST YEAR

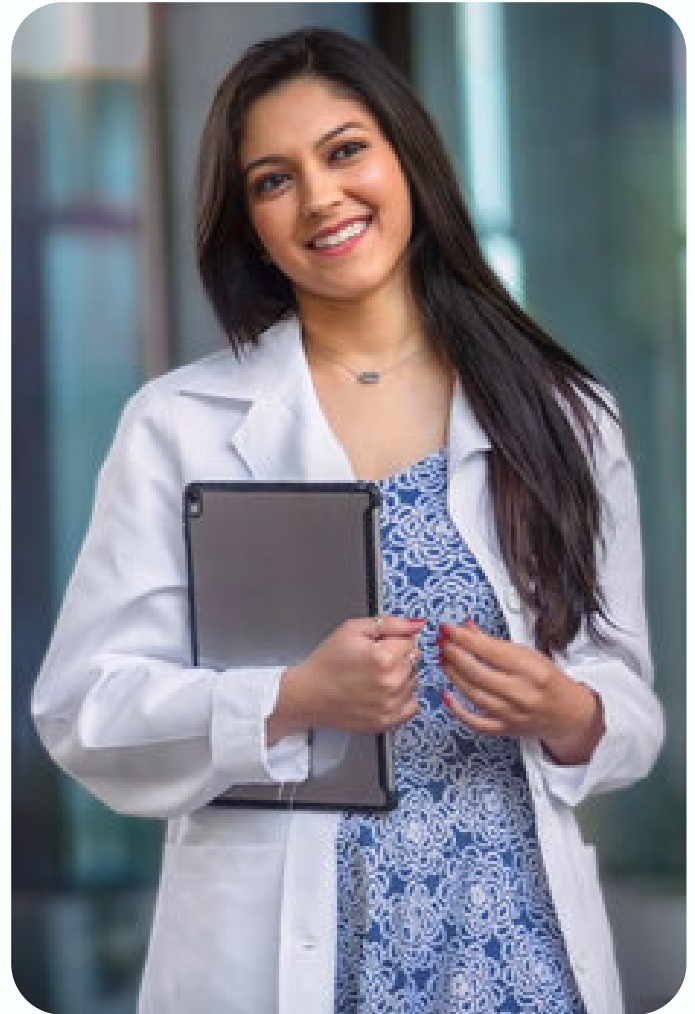

The second year offer the students an opportunity to develop a strong background in the basic medicines and to receive an introduction to the clinical medicine practice.

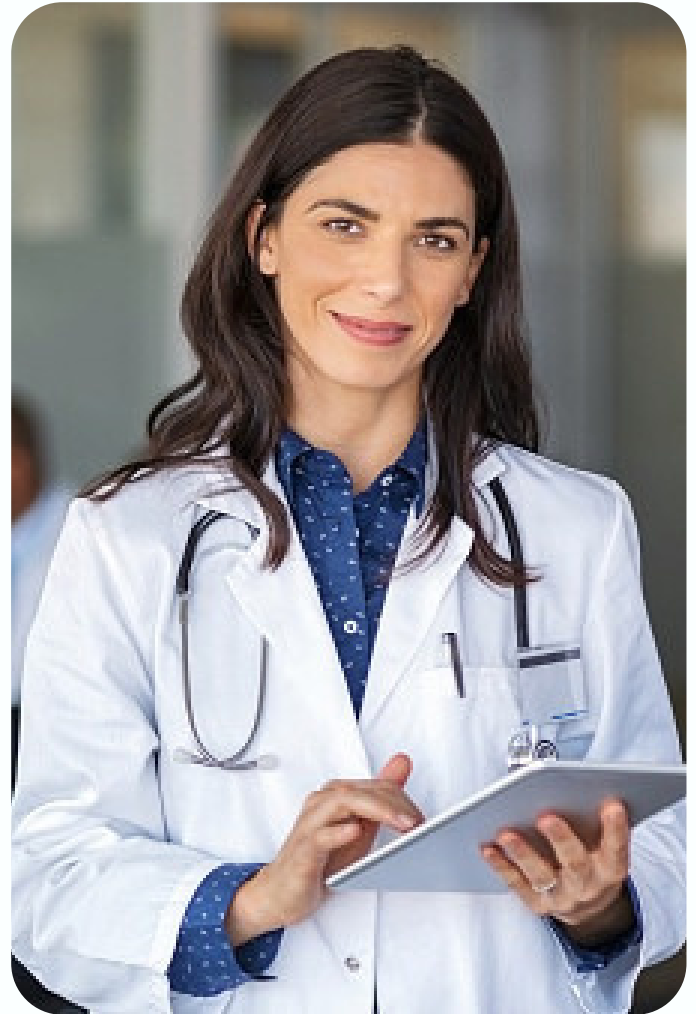

The third year offer the students an opportunity to develop a strong background in the basic surgery and to receive an introduction to the surgery practice.

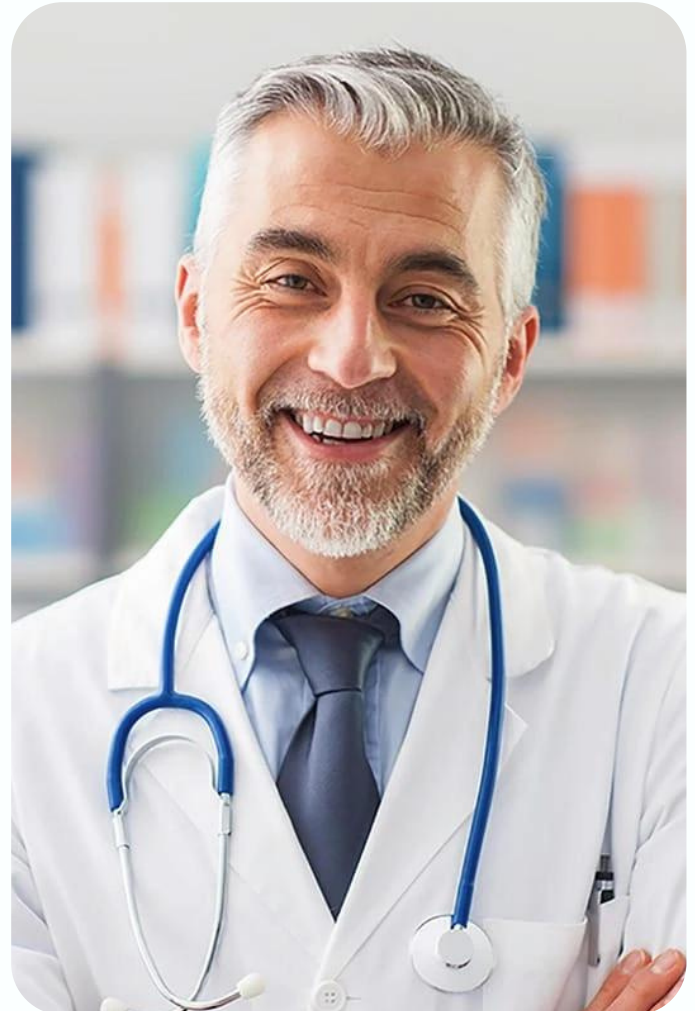

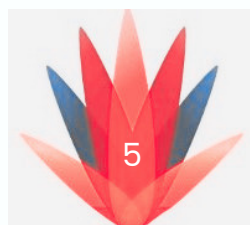

The fifth and sixth year offer the students to practice their medical profession under expert guidance and supervision beforehand of becoming a full-fledged medical practitioner.

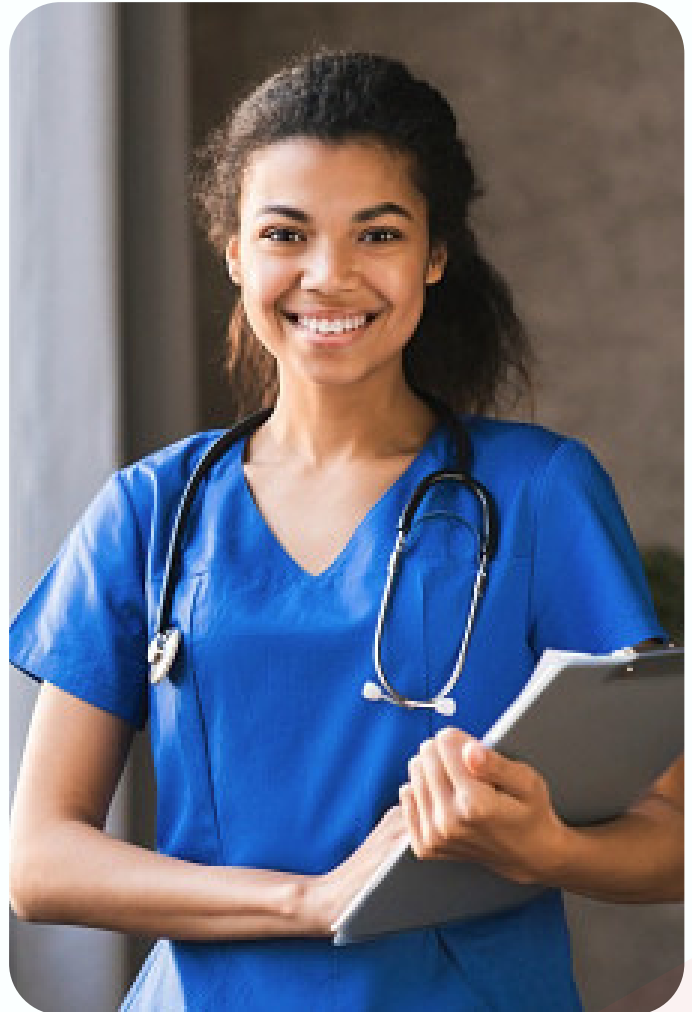

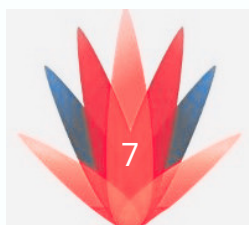
